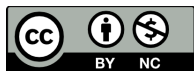

He always pulls my hair.

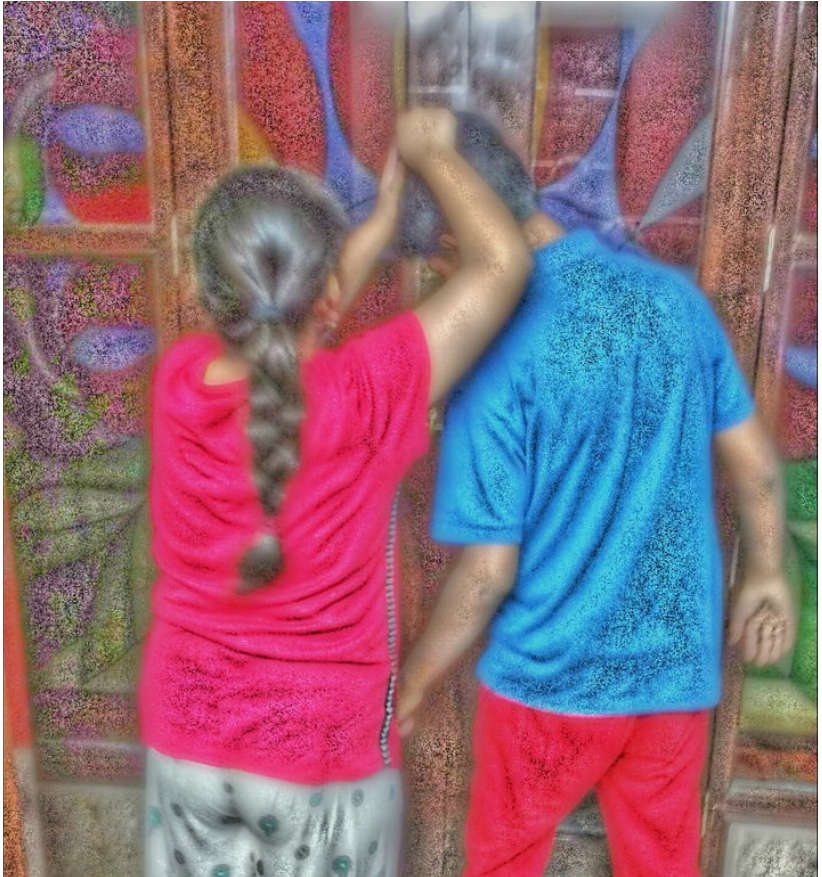
And he never gives me the TV remote.





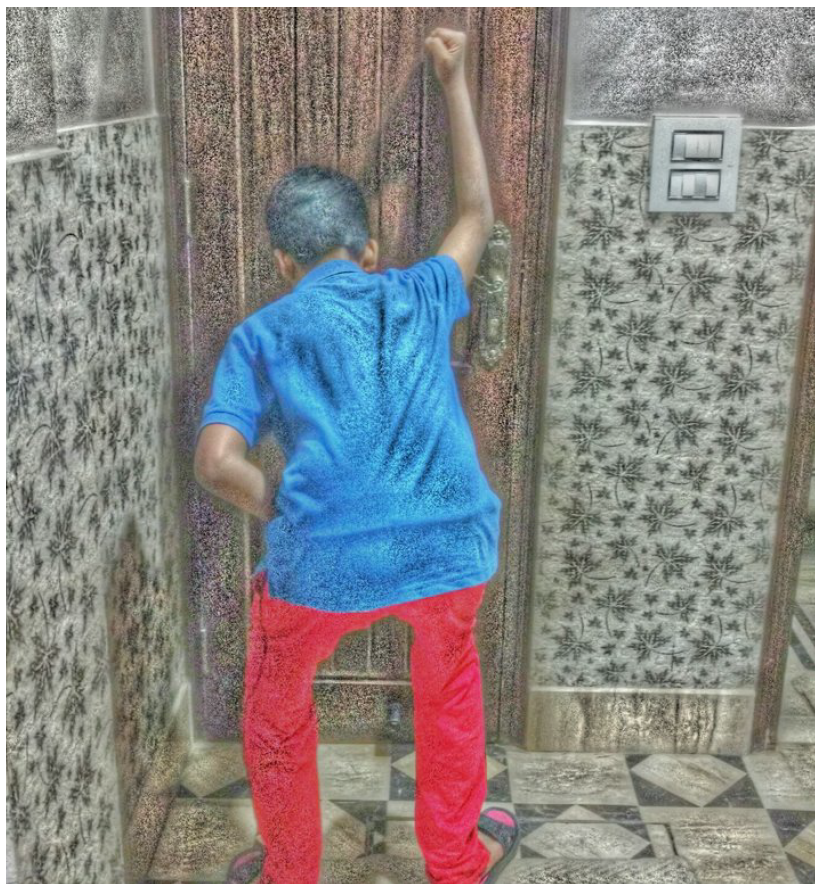
Once, he almost cut off my
