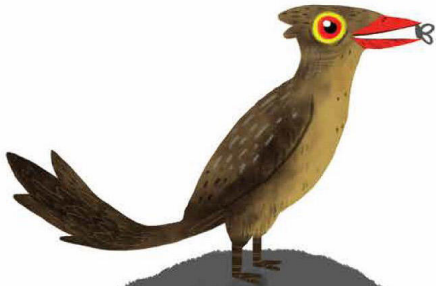


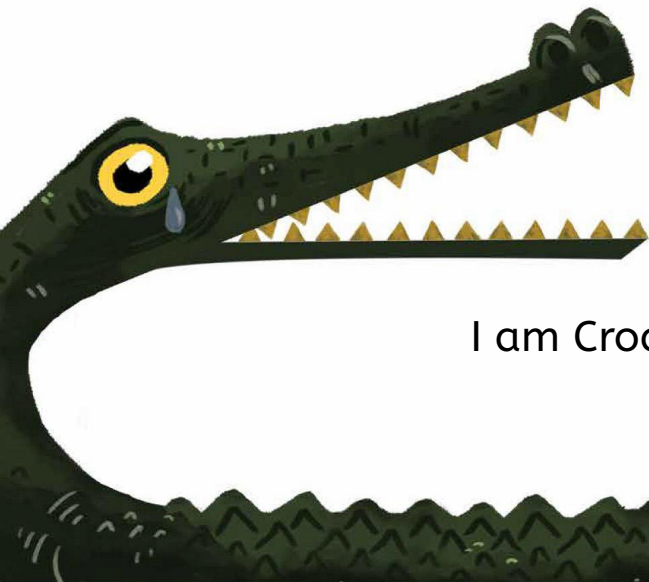
Our best friend is Bird!

I am Rhino. I get covered in fleas.

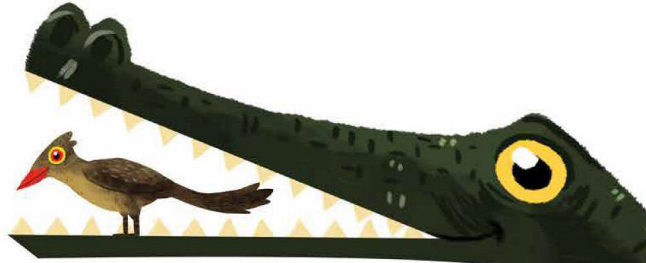


Bird eats them all up.
