

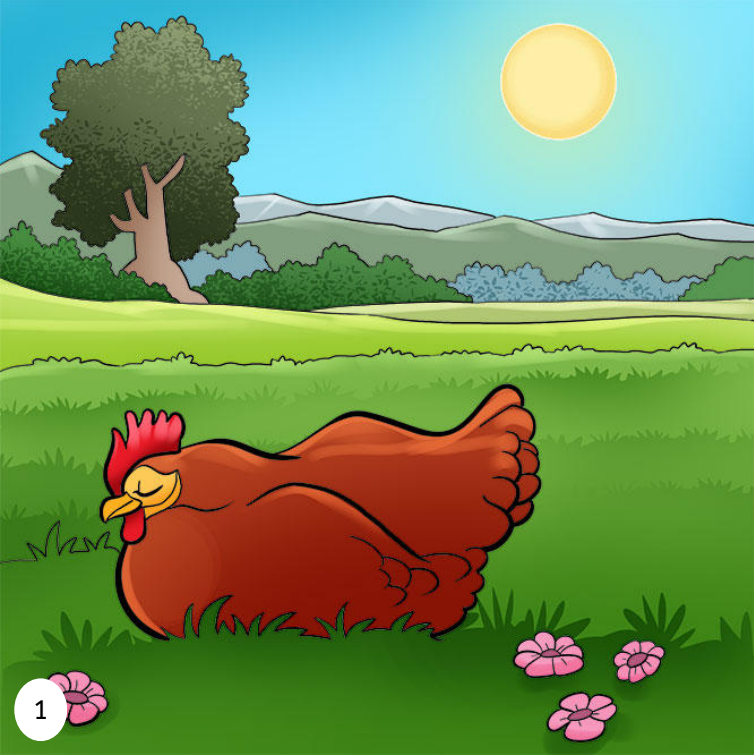

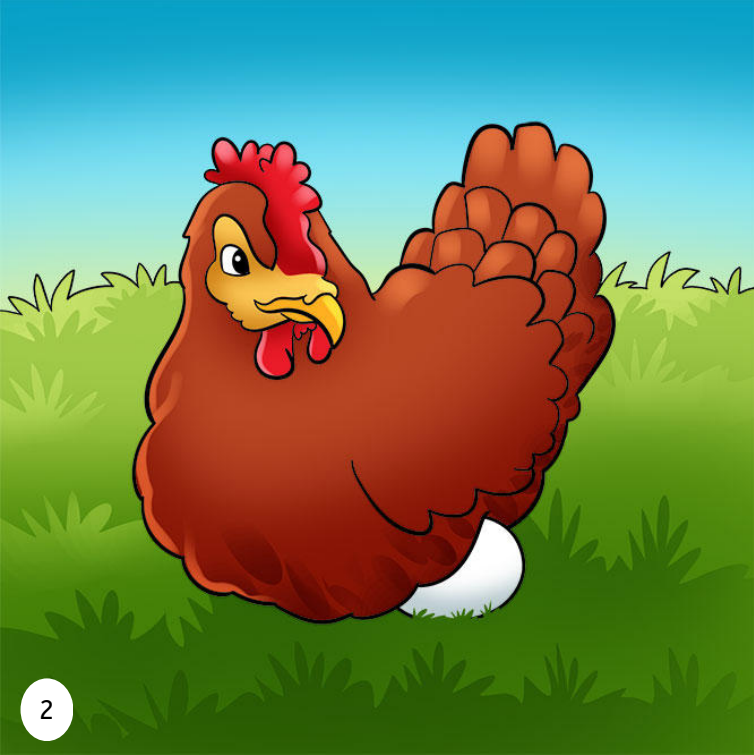

Peck, peck, peck!



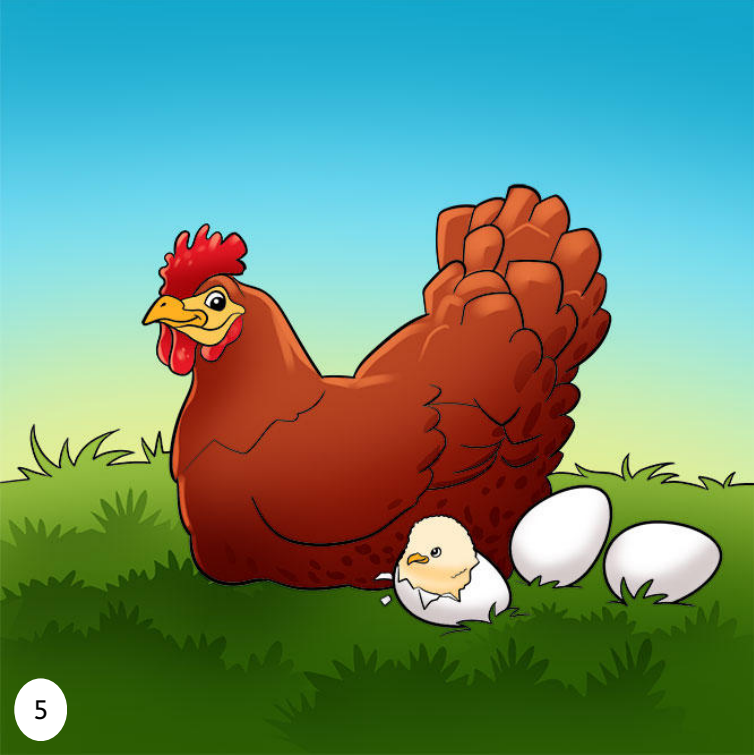
The red hen has an egg.
