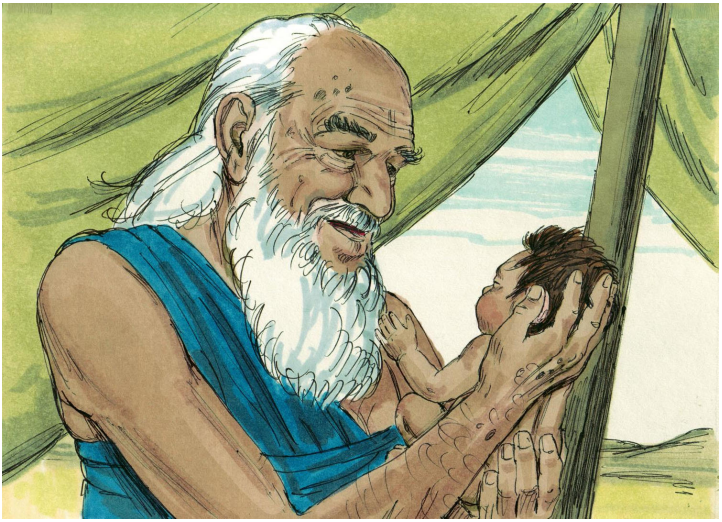

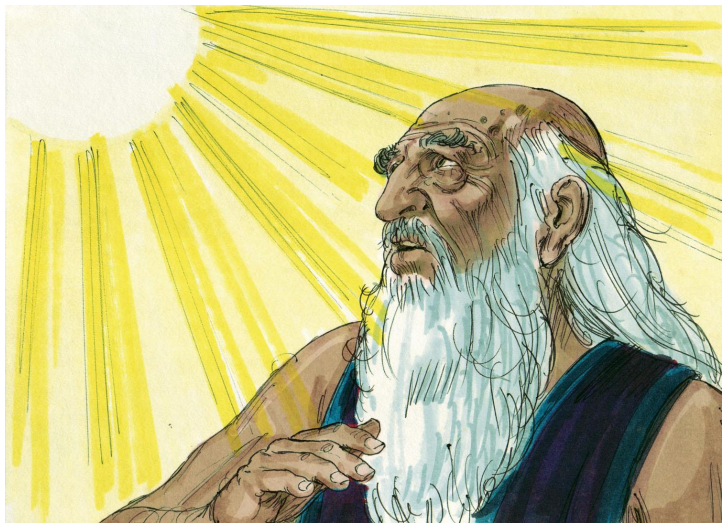

Gen 17:17; 18:10; 21:1-2



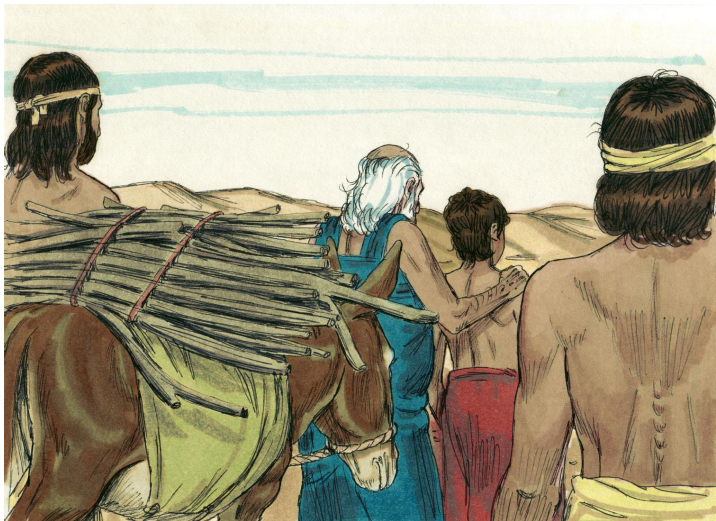
Abraham named his son Isaac. He obeyed God and circumcised Isaac when he was eight days old. Abraham loved his son Isaac very much!

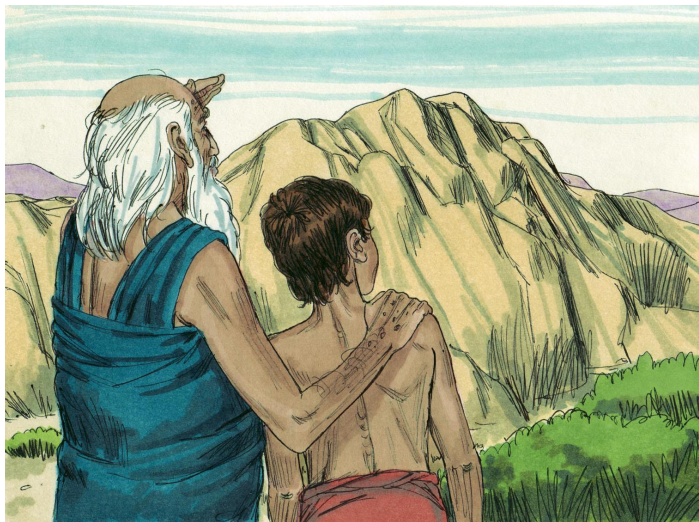

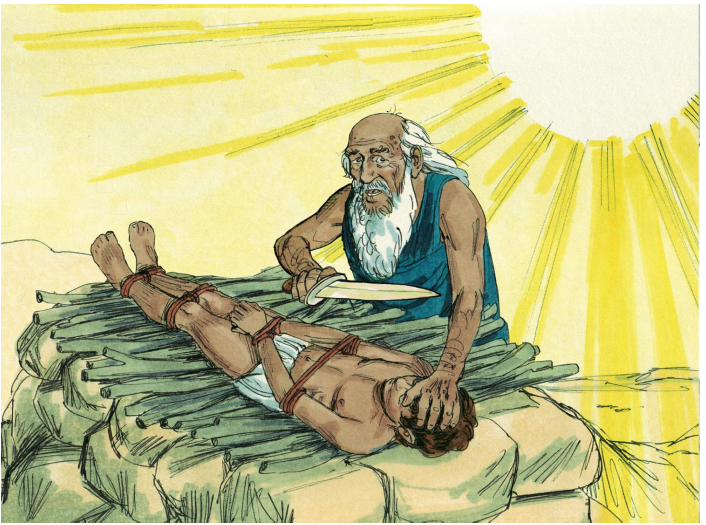
They arrived at the place where God told Abraham to go. Abraham piled stones to make an altar, and he put the wood on it.

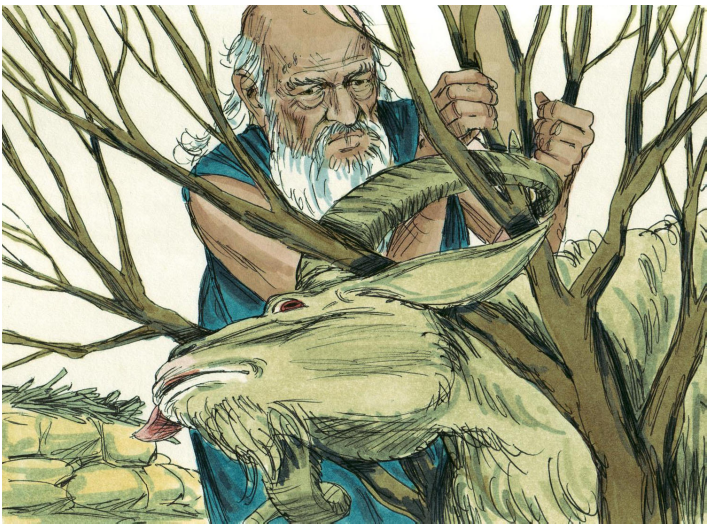
Then he tied up his son Isaac and placed him on the wood on the altar. Abraham picked up the knife to kill his son.

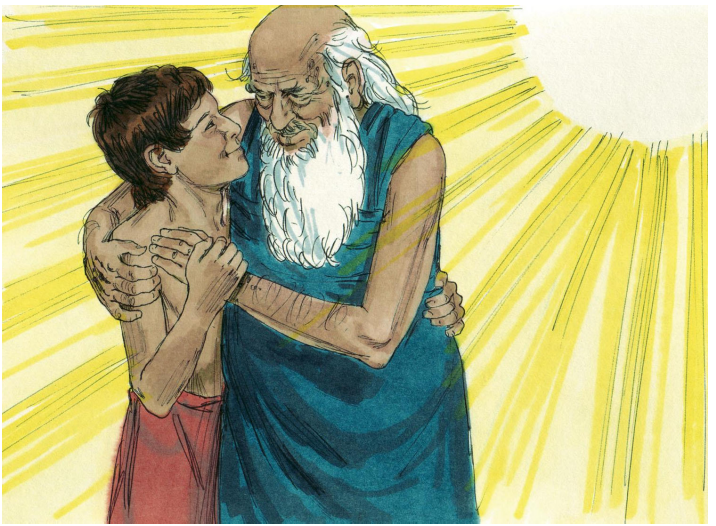
Abraham killed the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering on the altar in place of his son.

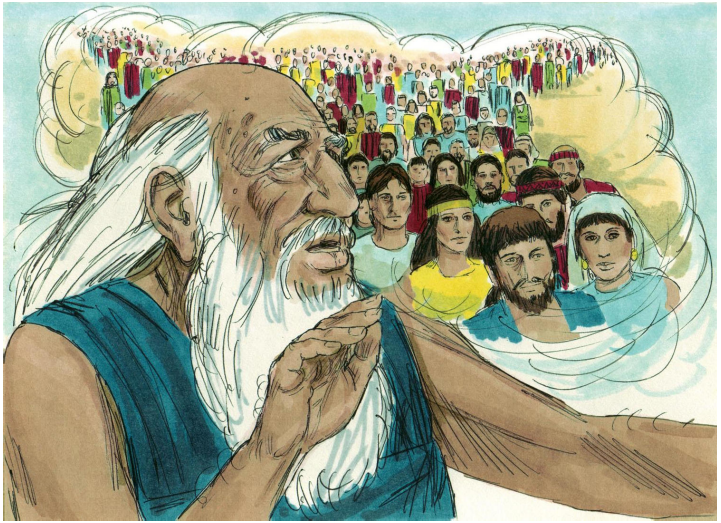
So Abraham called that place “The Lord Will Provide.”

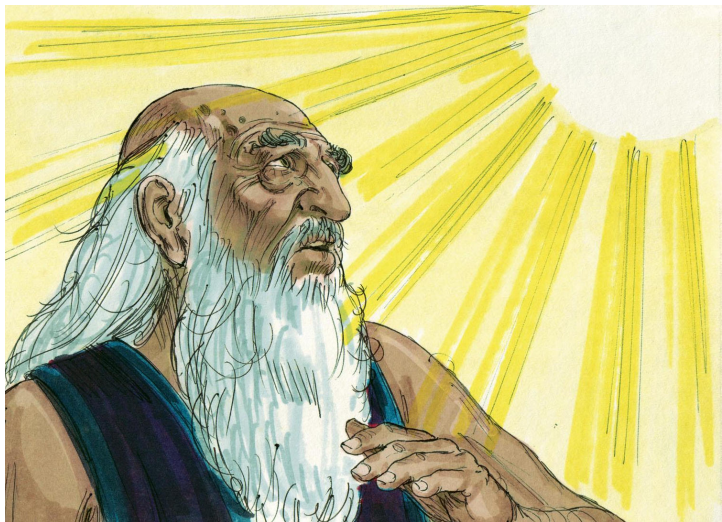
Then the Lord's angel spoke again to Abraham, "I will richly bless you. I will do this because you obeyed me and were willing to offer your only son to me, the Lord.

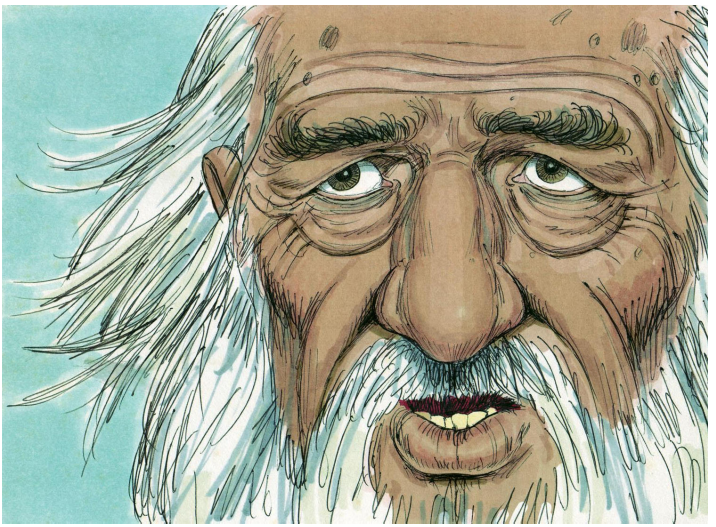
After this Abraham and Isaac went back to the servants who came with them and returned home.
