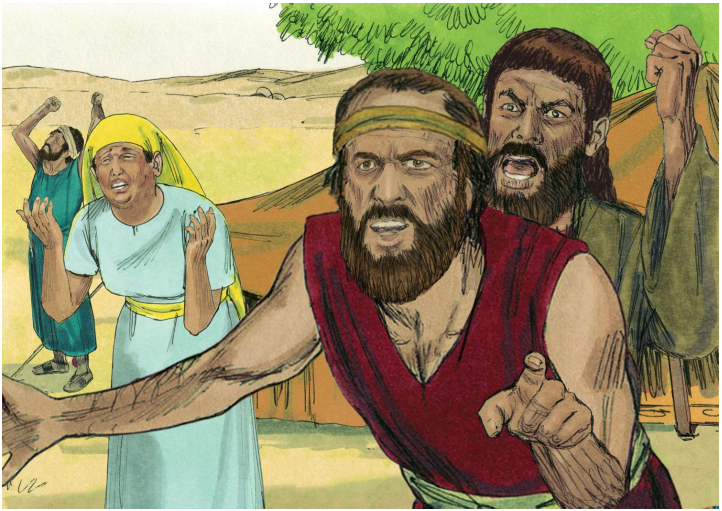

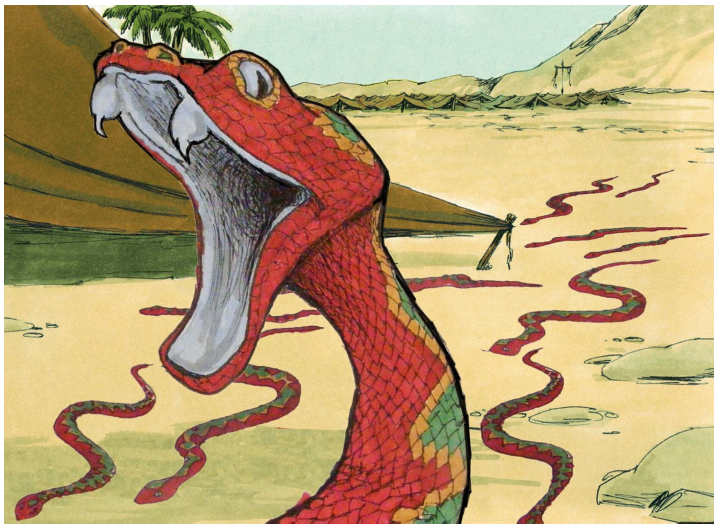

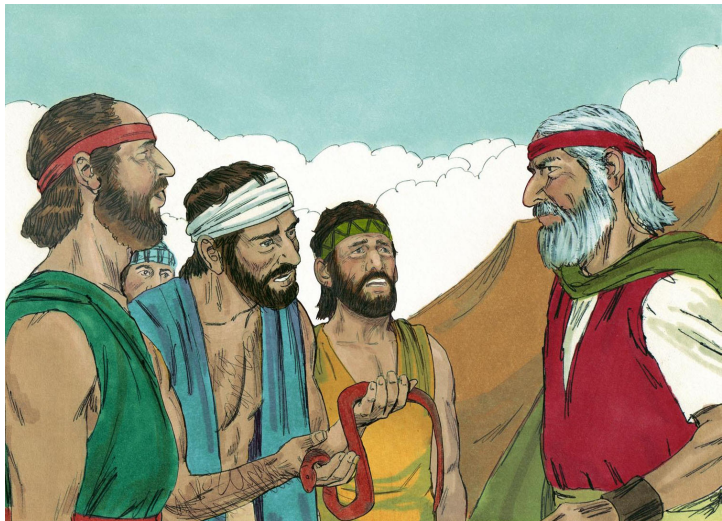
The snakes bit many people.

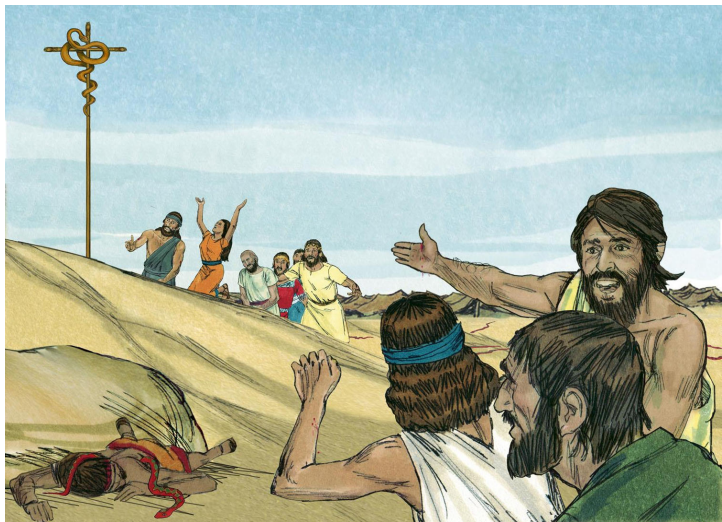
